## Garrison Public Library New Board Orientation

The Garrison Public Library is governed by its Board of Trustees. The Trustees are/can be recommended by the current board and appointed by the Mayor of Garrison, with council approval. It is a five member board that meets once a month for 11 months of the year.

The Garrison Library is governed by its by-laws, policies, Iowa Code and the Code of Garrison, IA, Chapter 21. The duties of the board are described in the by-laws, codes and Trustee Handbook.

Board appointments are for 6 years.

A person interested in becoming a board member can benefit by attending Library Board meetings and get on the job training prior to their appointment.

## **Upon appointment:**

- 1. New trustees will receive a link to the current Trustee Handbook
  - a. The trustee is expected to read the handbook
- 2. New trustees will be given a Board Book with current information
  - a. The trustee is expected to read information
- 3. New trustees will be encouraged to attend any online courses available for Library Trustees.
  - a. This is a state requirement to achieve and maintain tier 1 status
  - b. Some training may be during meetings
- 4. New trustees are encouraged to ask questions of current board and director.
- 5. New trustees will tour the library with the director and learn the services/programs provided, the daily operation, and about the building and grounds.
